Engaging -- Incorporating Worship

Mission Exists Because Worship Doesn't

God sends Jesus on his mission "in order that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy." Romans 15:9

He does his mighty works in history "that [his] name might be proclaimed in all the earth." Romans 9:17

Worship is the Goal and fuel of missions: Missions exists because worship doesn't.



So what do we mean by "worship"?

True worship is a valuing or a treasuring of God above all things.

The inner essence of worship is the response of the heart to the knowledge of the mind when the mind is rightly understanding God and the heart is rightly valuing God.

Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you. James 4:8



How do we engage our participants in worship?

Draw our gaze toward God by...

- 1. Using video worship song including lyrics
- 2. Using live worship with a single instrumentalist or group
- 3. Using responsive readings of scriptures, devotional readings, poetry, lectio divina, etc.
 - 4. Individual (or group) acapella singing
 - 5. Other forms of worship such as mime, dance, movement, banners, sign languages, natural scenic videos, etc.
 - 6. Incorporate some prayer on top of instrumental worship music
 - 7. Share communion together as an element of worship
 - 8. And however God gives you to creatively draw our eyes toward Him...
